

Sunnyvale Temple Rath Yatra Events for 2019

- **Snana Purnima:** June 16 (Sunday) 10AM -1PM
 - Devotees will perform Snana of the Deities with 108 pitchers of water mixed with various sugandhi dravyas
 - Deities go to *anabasara* on June 16th evening (after puja)
- **Anabasara:** June 17 – July 2 (No Darshan/ regular rituals)
 - Deities fall sick in the dark fortnight of *Aashadha* after heavy Snana and retreat to the Anabasara chamber. All regular rituals, including darshan, are suspended while the Deities are nursed back to health.
- **Netrotsava & Nava Youvan Darshan:** July 3, 6 PM
 - The resplendent Deities come out of the *Anabasara* to the sanctum sanctorum on the start of the bright fortnight of *Aashadha*
- **Rath Yatra:** July 6 (Saturday) 2 PM – 9 PM
 - Devotees will take the Deities out on a Chariot around the temple with pahandi and other associated rituals
 - Pahandi followed by Chariot pulling will start at **5pm**
 - Deities stay in the “Gundicha temple” (a separate mandapa for us) till Bahuda
- **Bahuda Yatra:** July 13 (Saturday) 10 AM – 1PM
 - Devotees will take the Deities back on the return Rath
 - Deities adorned in “Suna Vesha” on return to sanctum sanctorum
